- Community College, State College, University (Yes, all are automatically a member)
- Other Public agencies, including county, city, village, or agency of the state government, any drainage district, sanitary and improvement district, or other municipal corporation or political subdivision of the State of Nebraska (Yes, requires an Interlocal Agreement between agencies. See Steps below on how to become a member)
- Nonprofits (No, unless you are a public agency listed above. Nonprofits themselves do not qualify to be a member)
