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# Scottie Scheffler blitzes field at CJ Cup

There’s no place like home to win for the first time this season.

World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler clicked his heels and reminded everyone who’s the sheriff on the PGA Tour with a relentless performance at his hometown event, the CJ Cup Byron Nelson.

Scheffler, 28, fired a final-round 8-under-par 63 at TPC Craig Ranch in the Dallas suburb of McKinney, Texas, on May 4 to win by eight strokes over Erik van Rooyen.

“When I think about this tournament, I think about a lot of different stuff,” said Scheffler, listing off attending the tournament in his youth, making his first PGA Tour start in this event while in high school, among other reasons for his personal connection to it. “I think at times it all comes crashing down to me at once. We have a lot of great memories as kids coming to watch this tournament. I just dreamed to be able to play in it, and it’s more of a dream to be able to win it.”

As a 6-year-old, Scheffler had his picture taken with Nelson, a member of the World Golf Hall of Fame, at this event. Shown the picture following his victory, he said of Nelson, “He was great for the game of golf. He was a great person, a family man, and I’m proud to be the champion at his event.”

Eleven years later, Scheffler made the cut as an amateur with his sister on the bag, who is now the mother of two children, and his high school sweetheart – and now wife – walking every step in the gallery. He has supported the event ever since with the exception of last year, when he was awaiting the birth of his first child. Scheffler said reality has exceeded his dream.

“I always just dreamed of playing golf on the PGA Tour,” he said. “I would come out on the driving range and watch these guys practice, hitting their brand-new range balls. That’s all I wanted to do was come out here and play a golf course that was in great shape and compete on the best golf courses in the world against the best players.”

En route to victory, Scheffler rewrote much of the tournament record book, including setting a 72-hole scoring mark of 31-under 253, which also tied the PGA Tour’s all-time 72-hole scoring mark.

“It doesn’t matter where you’re playing, if you’re pushing it past 30 under that’s absolutely ridiculous, and that’s what he’s doing,” Jordan Spieth said.

Scheffler collected his 14th PGA Tour title and his first official victory since the Tour Championship in August. (He also won the Hero World Challenge, an unofficial event, in December.) But Scheffler injured his right hand on Christmas while making ravioli. He required surgery and missed a couple of early events. He recorded five top-10 finishes, including a second place at the Texas Children’s Houston Open, and hadn’t finished outside the top 25 in

eight starts this season, but hadn’t tasted victory.

Scheffler went wire-to-wire, opening with 10-under 61, following it up with 63 and admittedly lacking his A game shot a ho-hum 66 in the third round. The last golfer to have an eight-shot lead on the PGA Tour through 54 holes? McIlroy at the 2011 U.S. Open.

“(Scottie’s) the best player in the world for a reason,” said Adam Schenk, who finished T-5, before the final round. “I try to think of a situation where it’s an advantage to me to catch up to him tomorrow and I really can’t come up with one.”

With the exception of bogeys at the third and 17th holes, Scheffler never took his foot off the gas and continued his birdie binge, dropping circles on the card at four of the first seven holes. At

the par-5 ninth, Scheffler added a 21-foot eagle for good measure.

Van Rooyen, a South African, eagled No. 9 to shoot 30 on the front but didn’t trim his deficit. He holed a 56-foot eagle at No. 14 to shoot 8-under 63 and win the tournament’s “B” flight.

“Scottie was practically flawless, which is kind of what you expect from the world No. 1,” Van Rooyen said.

Scheffler was unstoppable, making birdies on three of the first six holes to start the back nine. For the week, he ranked first in strokes gained: tee to green, SG: approach the green and proximity to the hole. Scheffler made the game look as easy as the tournament namesake, who once won 11 straight tournaments in 1945.

Golf Channel analyst Brandel Chamblee went so far as to compare Scheffler’s tee-to-green game to Tiger Woods’ in his heyday.

“I never thought I’d say that, I never thought I’d see that, but tee to green he’s Tiger Woods,” Chamblee said.

Scheffler’s putter wasn’t too shabby either, ranking first in SG: putting in the final round and fifth for the week.

Another hometown hero, Spieth, who battled the 36-hole cutline, fired a bogey-free 62 and finished fourth.

But Spieth still couldn’t sniff Scheffler.

“He’s just playing the golf he’s played over the last few years,” Spieth said. “He’s hitting the fairway and then ironing it maybe better than anybody ever has and lets the birdies come to him. The courses become really easy once you have an average of like 10 feet for birdie. Golf becomes pretty easy.”

“When he’s like this and he’s making putts, you have to somehow find an advantage over him.”

But at the CJ Cup, Scheffler was a man among boys and sent a message to McIlroy and anyone else thinking of winning the PGA Championship in two weeks time, that he’s back and ready to do battle for more majors.

“It feels like a lifetime of hard work and sacrifice for little moments like these, and they’re pretty special,” he said.

# As grand slam chance looms, Spieth closes in 62

Jordan Spieth is finding his form at an opportune time.

The Dallas native closed in 9-under 62 on May 4 at the CJ Cup Byron Nelson, the 62 being Spieth’s lowest score on the PGA Tour since 2021.

He gained 6.464 strokes on the field in his final round, his best performance since the final round of the 2023 Masters.

After offseason wrist surgery and a few years of questioning whether Spieth could return to peak form, he seems to finally be finding it, and at a good time, too. The PGA Championship begins in just over a week, and Spieth needs the Wanamaker Trophy to become the sev-

enth male golfer to win the career grand slam.

It’s something he talked about with CBS Sports’ Amanda Balionis in his post-round interview, and he said seeing

Rory McIlroy accomplish the feat last month at the Masters was inspiring.

“The ultimate goal is consistent play, but it’s not bogey avoidance or anything like that,” Spieth said. “I’m not changing strategy. It’s just that my mechanics are just getting a little bit better each week. I’m able to do sufficient stuff maybe that I wasn’t able to do last year that maybe my wrist is holding me back, I’m not sure.”

The finish at his hometown event will

be Spieth’s third top-10 of 2025, and his worst finish in his past five starts was a T-28 at the Valspar Championship.

“You can go in lulls, and I know that you can bounce out of them literally in a hole or two,” he said. “Sometimes when you’re putting well, you have to have a lot of rounds that are bad in order to not feel good. But the good news is bipolarness on the greens can bounce back to positive pretty quickly.”

Even with his stellar closing round, Spieth was going to finish at least 10 shots behind fellow Dallas native Scottie Scheffler, who Spieth played with the first two days and plays golf with often during off weeks.

“It’s inspiring what he’s doing. It makes me want to work harder and be better, especially after watching him for

two days and just getting my butt kicked,” Spieth said. “I didn’t play great golf, but even if I did, it would have been hard to be at 18-under in two rounds. I don’t think I’ve ever done that.”

Spieth is in the field at this week’s Trusti Championship on a sponsor exemption, his second of what will be five straight starts on the PGA Tour, ending at the Memorial. But after next weekend, he heads to Quail Hollow Club, where he went 5-0-0 during the 2022 Presidents Cup and where he had his first chance to complete the career grand slam in 2017, though he got beat by good friend Justin Thomas.

Spieth is trending, and he knows it. “It feels close,” Spieth said. “I’m not going to try to force anything, and this was a good improvement.”

# Derek Carr’s legacy: The Good. The Bad. The courageous.

It may seem weird to ask about the legacy of someone like quarterback Derek Carr, who recently retired. Carr was never one of the elite pass throwers. He’s not one of those quarterbacks where words like “legacy” are normally used. That word is normally reserved for someone like Joe Montana. Not Derek Carr.

Yet Carr does have a legacy. It’s the legacy of the luck of the draw. In Carr’s case, bad luck. Like so many other quarterbacks before him, you have to wonder what his career would have been like had he not played for such problematic franchises.

It’s likely Tom Brady would be Tom Brady in any of the multiverses, but what if Brady had played for six head coaches in his career as Carr did instead of one? Do we *know* he’d be Brady with that kind of constant upheaval? If he played for bad coaches? For organizations that were inept?

Many of the players who start at quarterback in the league are like Carr. They aren’t elite talents. They are the NFL’s workhorses. They don’t have the skill of Peyton Manning or the athleticism of John Elway. They’re the middle class. In many instances, they are also unlucky. That partly was Carr.

Carr’s story is universal in the NFL. It will be the story of quarterbacks from this past draft like Cam Ward, Shedeur Sanders or Jaxson Dart. Their success

will depend on numerous circumstances beyond their control.

It’s easy to be critical of Carr’s career. I have been in the past. Never liked how he’d throw teammates under multiple buses. But on the field he’s been far better than people think despite some absolutely brutal circumstances. As ESPN notes, Carr played for a staggering six head coaches in his nine years with the Raiders. Two of those coaches were interim. There were five different play-callers. He also had a new coordinator in each of his two seasons with the Saints.

It’s difficult to overstate how unbelievably bad those circumstances are. Few quarterbacks would be able to prosper with that kind of turnover. Yet Carr somehow did. He made Pro Bowls and was as tough as they come. Carr would

get annihilated behind some bad offensive lines with both the Raiders and the Saints. Yet he’d get hit and get right back up. He played in 15 or more games, ESPN says, in each of his first 10 NFL seasons.

Carr was genuinely a highly courageous player, especially with the Raiders.

Carr was far from perfect, of course. He would make some of the most inexplicable interceptions you’d ever see. Just head-scratching stuff. Carr was once blasted by a former teammate who ranted that the quarterback was an inaccurate thrower.

Carr also had just one career playoff appearance (a loss in an AFC wild-card game in 2022 while with the Raiders). He was good, at times even top 10 at his position, but not good enough to put bad

franchises on his back and win postseason contests.

For someone of his stature (an NFL quarterback), Carr could also be remarkable thin-skinned. He’d go on blocking splees on Twitter (now X) after even mild criticism. It became almost a running joke. There were two types of Twitter users: those blocked by Carr and those who would be. He blocked me years ago. I also just checked. I’m still blocked.

Carr was once asked why he puts so much effort into blocking people.

“You probably said something silly,” Carr replied. “You probably said something crazy. I mute and block people all the time. You maybe didn’t even say it about me, you maybe said it about one of my best friends, man. And so I’m sorry that it’s come to this. If you wanna go have lunch, we can have lunch, man. From six feet distance, with masks on. All the protocols. You know, I’m not tryin’ to get in trouble in the city again, you know?”

“So we can do that. But I block, man. Some of you all probably got blocked on here, too. But we’re still friends. You know? I just don’t want to read the negativity, man. I don’t want someone to tweet it or come at. I don’t wanna see it. So it’s nothin’ personal, man. That’s social media. I’m still me in person, you know?”

It was an honest answer. I’ll give him that.

So what is Carr’s legacy? He was a solid player who made the best of his limited talent while playing on (mostly) bad teams. No, it’s not a Brady-type legacy.

But it’s not bad, either.

## Jags coach reveals Hunter’s workout plan for rookie minicamp

The Jacksonville Jaguars began the unique challenge of preparing Travis Hunter to play both offense and defense as their NFL rookie minicamp opened over the weekend.

Hunter began minicamp working at the wide receiver position. First-year Jaguars coach Liam Coen provided insight into when interested parties might see the rookie at cornerback during a media availability May 10.

“Yeah, he’ll be able to get integrated next week on the defensive side of the ball,” Coen told reporters, per NFL Network.

Why did the Jaguars begin with Hunter working at receiver for multiple sessions? Jacksonville’s goal was to see Hunter make strides at the position before also testing him at cornerback.

“We just kind of ended up making a decision that from yesterday to today we wanted to be able to clean up some of the things that we may have been able to miss yesterday, get extra reps on the of-

fensive side of the ball, and next week he’ll start to roll on defense,” Coen explained.

Many expect Hunter to play receiver primarily during his first NFL season, which may also have played a part in Jacksonville’s decision.

Hunter appears to be on board with the Jaguars’ plan. He said he was “getting used to” learning two NFL playbooks but acknowledged learning Jacksonville’s offense was the more challenging task.

“It’s just a lot of different types of calls, but other than that, the defense is pretty

easy,” Hunter said. “You’ve just got to get used to the offense.”

Coen seems confident Hunter won’t have any issues picking things up on both sides of the ball after winning the Heisman Trophy while doing so at Colorado.

“He’s a football-smart guy,” Coen said of Hunter. “The game makes sense to him. And so now it’s just about putting in that time, that extra time that he’s going to have to do in order to be successful to play even one side of the ball at this level. So he knows what’s cut out for him coming up.”

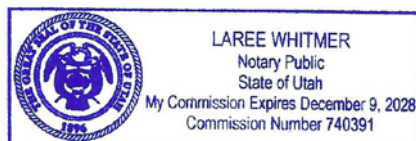
