## Cameron Young crushes first tour victory

GREENSBORO, NC - The party at Sleepy Hollow Country Club, where Cameron Young learned to play the game, began early at the Pool Pavilion Bar at his 1:55 p.m. starting time Aug. 3. The club in Briarcliff Manor, New York, offered \$3 beer, wine and cocktails for every birdie, free drinks for an eagle and an open bar for an hour if he were to win.

About the only thing Young didn't do was make an eagle, but the 28-year-old pro, whose father, David, served as the club's professional for 20 years, took care of business, shooting 2-under 68 at Sedgefield Country Club and blitzing the field by six strokes to win the Wyndham Championship.

Mac Meissner closed with 66 to finish second, a stroke better than Mark Hubbard and Alex Noren.

Young, who played his college golf at nearby Wake Forest University, finally tasted victory in style after finishing runner-up seven times, the most of any player on the PGA Tour without a victory since 2003.

"It feels like a long time coming," he said. "I felt like for the first year and a half that I was out here I had a chance to win every third week it felt like. They've been a bit more few and far between, so to have a chance like this today, I was not going to let it get away from me and I'm thankful that I didn't."

Young had never held a 54-hole lead or co-lead until he shot rounds of 63-62-65 to build a five-stroke advantage.

In the final round, he bogeyed the first hole, trimming his lead to four momentarily, but it proved to be a wake-up call as he responded by pouring in five straight birdies beginning at the second hole. His lead grew to as many as nine.

He said he decided to return to playing a draw this week, his preferred ball flight when he was younger, and it was the key to victory.

"I might have heeled a driver that has gone left to right, but I think every other shot has been right to left," he said. "I had the inclination to try to like see what it felt like to hit something straighter today and just didn't."

It didn't hurt that his putter remained red hot all week. After ranking 145th in strokes gained: putting last season, he entered the week in 10th place in the category. At the Wyndham Championship, he ranked first and chalked it up to technical tweaks to his setup and a lot of practice.

"I was rolling it great. Nice to see a bunch of them in a row find the bottom," he said, including a 26-foot birdie putt at No. 3.

After his early birdie spree - he played the front nine in 18 under for the week - he waltzed to victory with 10 pars and bogeys at 16 and 17, a 72-hole scoring total of 22-under 258, and became the 1,000th first-time winner on the PGA Tour. Heading into the Truist Championship in early May, Young was mired in 83rd place in the FedExCup season-long standings.

'There's thoughts in the back of your mind like what if I finish 104th? So I kind of told myself that I can't let that happen," said Young, who improved to No. 16 in the points race and well positioned for a return to East Lake and the Tour Championship, the final of three legs of the FedExCup playoffs.

"Everyone knew how good he was," said Webb Simpson, a fellow Demon Deacon. "There's plenty of guys who we think are good enough to win, but you're still not sure until you do it. He was a little different knowing, like we knew, everyone knew how good he was.'

He added of Young, who already has played on the 2022 U.S. Presidents Cup team, "I think he has a very high ceiling ... I think this will be one of those situations where he'll be a guy we're talking about for 10 or 15 years.'

Young grew up at Sleepy Hollow and piled up wins on the home front. At the age of 14, he became the youngest winner of the Westchester Amateur. Young won the Ike Championship in 2015 and 2016 and was the Met Player of the Year

He'd like nothing more than a homecoming of sorts as a member of the U.S. Ryder Cup team next month at Bethpage Black, where he once held the course record, carding a final-round 64 to become the first amateur to win the New York State Open in 2017. Young improved to No. 15 in the U.S Ryder Cup points standings with two tournaments remaining and put U.S. captain Keegan Bradley on notice that he deserves serious consideration for a captain's pick

"Anytime you're about to win by 10, you've got to talk about him," said Simpson, one of Bradley's vice captains. "And he certainly has the right game for that golf course. He's just adding his name to the list of many guys that are hard for us to say no to."

The members at Sleepy Hollow will drink to that.

## Japan women's golden era reigns at 2025 majors

As golf's major season comes to end, the LPGA's historic march of champions rolls on. One day after Japan's Miyu Yamashita celebrated her 24th birthday, the petite Japanese star gave herself what she surely wanted most: a major

Yamashita becomes the tour's 21st different winner this season, closing with a 2-under 70 to finish at 11 under and edge out English sensation Charley Hull and compatriot Minami Katsu by two strokes at the AIG Women's British Open.

The record number of champions to this point in the season stands in stark contrast to 2024, when Nelly Korda won seven times and Lydia Ko played her way into the LPGA Hall of Fame. From dominance to diversity, Yamashita becomes the ninth first-time winner on tour this season.

Korda is projected to fall from her perch as world No. 1, overtaken by Thailand's Jeeno Thitikul.

"This has been a goal of mine, something I've worked towards my whole life, a dream you could say," said Yamashita through the aid of an interpreter. "It's been the result of hard work every single day, making changes, making improvements, and to be able to do it now and call myself a champion is a very special

A 13-time winner on the JLPGA, Yamashita is a rookie on the LPGA in name only given her vast success on home soil, including three majors on that tour. She came into the Women's British Open ranked 15th in the world. She leaves with a trophy and a big payday. The first-place prize this year was

The week began with England's newest star Lottie Woad the bookmakers' betting favorite in only her second professional start. A late triple-bogey in her second round halted Woad's bid to win two in a row, but a top-10 finish for a second straight year in this championship is a fine showing, given her recent whirlwind stretch.

"Just walking out from the first tee, I got a loud cheer," said Woad, "and I could tell everyone was rooting for me. That was nice."

Woad ultimately took a share of

Yamashita's good fortune started with the pairings, when she found herself grouped with good friend and compatriot Rio Takeda for the first two rounds, a rare opportunity on the LPGA.

That comfortable pairing along with the luck of the draw in weather going off late/early in the first two rounds helped her build a three-shot lead heading into the weekend.

In the third round, however, the straight player with the sweet short game suddenly turned crooked and her putter went ice cold, taking 34 putts.

NBC booth analyst Morgan Pressel summed it up best as Yamashita limped home at Royal Porthcawl: "Almost everything has gone wrong for Miyu Yamashita, and she's still in the lead."

She stayed on the range late in the evening with her father trying to straighten out a two-way miss.

"When we got home, we were together, we looked through some of the finer details on the swing, found some points to improve," she said, "and today it felt a lot better just from the get go."

The weather started out rough for the final round with rain, wind and cold keeping the early-goers from making much of a move.

Perhaps it was Yamashita's cheery vellow sweater that coaxed out the sun late in the afternoon as the leaders made their way along the coast.

Stanford's Paula Martin Sampedro showed what was possible down the stretch at Porthcawl, as she put an exclamation point on her week in Wales with a back-nine 30 that included five consecutive birdies. It marked the lowest inward nine for the week by two

The Spaniard, who played alongside two-time Smyth Salver winner Lydia Ko, closed with a 4-under 68 to zoom up the board and cap a summer that included victories at the British Women's Amateur and European Ladies' Amateur Championship in Germany.

South Korea's A Lim Kim entered the final round one back and was the only player on the board who'd previously won a major, the 2020 U.S. Women's Open. The powerful, aggressive Kim looked timid in back-to-back bogevs on the third and fourth holes and never posed a serious threat down the stretch.

Yamashita, meanwhile, played the first four holes better than most, picking up three strokes on the field with superior scrambling. Whatever ailed her game the day before had disappeared.

The always-entertaining Hull was 11 back to start the third round and pulled within one of Yamashita, much to the delight of the home crowd. As the fast-walking, fast-talking Hull

electrified crowds with a rare birdie on the most difficult 14th, Yamashita stayed steady, pouring in par putts to keep her advantage.

Hull's chances began to wane after back-to-back bogeys on Nos. 16 and 17 as Yamashita's lead ballooned to three strokes with three to play.

Yamashita, who leads the tour in scrambling and bogey-free rounds, dropped a shot on the 17th but, after Hull failed to make birdie on the closing par 5, headed to the 72nd hole with a twostroke cushion.

Her two-stroke victory gives Japan bookend titles at the majors, with Mao Saigo winning the first at the Chevron Championship, and four titles on the season from four Japanese different winners. Yamashita becomes the sixth major champion from Japan, and the fourth in the last two seasons.

"So great to see Saigo win earlier this year," said Yamashita, "and just kind of push me a little bit harder."

## Palou clinches 4th title

PORTLAND, OR – Alex Palou put to bed what can only be deemed one of the most dominant championship performances the IndyCar Series has ever seen, capturing his fourth season championship with two races left to contest before the season is complete.

Will Power, the 44-year-old veteran whose future with Team Penske is uncertain, won the Bitnile.com Grand Prix of Portland by 1.6 seconds over Christian Lundgaard. Power earned his 45th career win and first since last year's Portland race.

By virtue of his third-place finish at Portland International Raceway on Sunday, Aug. 10, Palou increased his cushion over Pato O'Ward to 151 points.

O'Ward entered the weekend as Palou's only mathematical challenger and started on the pole but had a power failure after the restart on lap 21, causing him to go eight laps down. With only a maximum of 108 points to be earned over the final two race weekends at the Milwaukee Mile (Aug. 23-24) and Nashville Superspeedway (Aug. 30-31), O'Ward no longer holds any chance to pull off what for weeks would've been maybe the most miraculous championship comeback.

A title fight the 26-year-old Mexican driver has frequently deemed "over" recently, always accompanied with a chuckle, is now formally so, with Palou going wire-to-wire for his fourth title in five seasons, all since joining Chip Ganassi Racing for the start of the 2021 IndyCar campaign off the back of a 2020 rookie season that even days ahead of signing with CGR had left him uncertain if his career would last beyond a single season.

The 28-year-old Spaniard won that 2021 season opener and was off to the races, like he was this season.

Unlike that debut campaign with Ganassi, or any major American openwheel season of any kind since A.J. Fovt's in 1979, Palou would go on to win five of the first six races of the season, a feat matched only three times in the sport's history. And in only one of those spectacular seasons, Foyt's 1964 campaign, did one of those drivers ride their early hot streak to not only an Indianapolis 500 victory as well as a championship, as Palou has now done. It's the first time in 15 years (Dario Franchitti, 2010) that a driver has paired a championship with a chance to kiss the bricks in the same calendar year.

It's unclear whether Palou may match Foyt's all-time series mark of 10 wins in a season (a record matched, but not beaten, by Al Unser Sr. in 1970). But with eight victories, it makes Palou's season, and his six-year resume, already one of the best the sport has seen.






