COLLEGE FOOTBALL WEEK 1 OVERREACTIONS

Ohio State, LSU now CFP favorites?

An action-packed opening weekend of college football in the books. As always, fans throughout the country are either at the pinnacle of elation or in the depths of despair.

OK, there are probably some who are in between those extremes, but we're not concerned with them here. This space is all about overreactions, and boy were there a lot of things worthy of hyperbole this week.

For the uninitiated, here's how this works. The following statements are all conclusions some have drawn from the weekend's results.

Some of them might prove to be accurate, while others might truly be overreactions gleaned from putting too much weight on the first games of the season. We'll try and sort the reasonable from the over-the-top.

● **Ohio State is running the table**

One side of the ball was undeniably in championship form for the Buckeyes, and it's fair to assume the offense will get more efficient over the course of the season. With the Texas hurdle cleared, the rest of the Buckeyes schedule looks quite navigable.

The Buckeyes go to the West Coast just once, heading to Washington at the end of September, there's no Oregon or Southern Cal on the regular-season docket, and Penn State has to come to Columbus.

Ah, but there's still the small matter of the one demon Ohio State has struggled to conquer in the Ryan Day era — archrival Michigan.

Then a few weeks before that season-ending visit to Ann Arbor, Ohio State will pay a visit to Illinois, a team projected as a possible Big Ten sleeper.

Clearly the Buckeyes now have a return path to the College Football Playoff, but perfection is hard in the modern game.

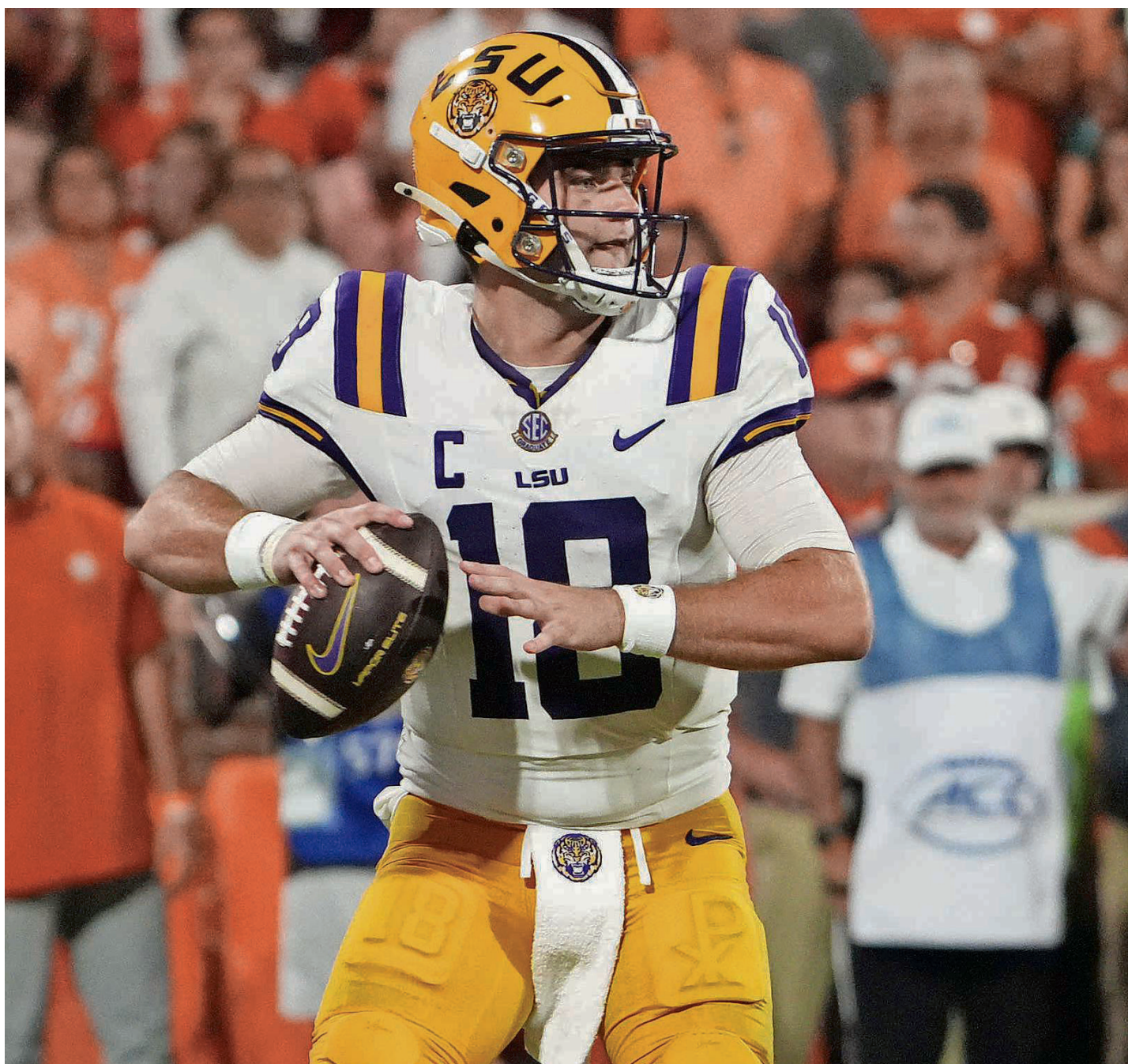
● **LSU is going to win the SEC**

The Tigers assuredly had the league's best result of opening weekend. Looking ahead, their conference slate does not include Georgia or Texas, and that Nov. 8 trip to Alabama suddenly appears less daunting.

But if we've learned anything from watching the SEC over the years, it's that we should never take any result for granted, especially with so many other possible conference contenders still untested. As many as three ranked conference opponents could be coming to Baton Rouge, starting with Florida in a couple of weeks. Then the campaign will wrap up at Oklahoma, where late Playoff pushes have been known to come unraveled.

● **Clemson is fine after LSU loss**

As we saw last year, a season-opening loss to an SEC opponent is not fatal to Clemson's Playoff prospects. The Tigers are still widely considered the team to beat in the ACC, even if the league just got a bit more crowded with Florida State reentering the picture and Miami's emergence against Notre Dame.

Just getting to the Playoff, however, is not the standard at Clemson. The LSU contest was just the kind of game the Tigers haven't shown they can win since claiming their last title in 2018.

As mentioned, they did make the 12-team field last year after a much more decisive opening loss to Georgia. But they also lost to South Carolina to close the regular season and were thoroughly outclassed by Texas in the Playoff.

In other words, when you go 0-3 against SEC competition, you can't really think about national championships. And that Tigers offense that was supposed to be flashier? Still not much flash. That will also need to improve by the time December rolls around.

● **Notre Dame is in trouble**

On the surface, a road loss to a top-10 team shouldn't be damaging. The Fighting Irish, after all, overcame a much worse loss last season and were still able to assemble a resume deemed Playoff-worthy.

But here's the problem. Now Notre Dame is at the mercy of its future opponents to provide opportunities for qual-

ity wins. The Irish next take the field in two weeks when they host Texas A&M.

After that, there are no teams currently in the Top 25 on Notre Dame's schedule (Boise State was out of the rankings when the new poll came out Tuesday, Sept. 2).

The polls aren't the final determinant of what makes a quality opponent, of course, but the Irish must hope future foes like Southern Cal, NC State or Navy win enough games to make beating them count. Then, it goes without saying the Irish must actually beat them all. It can be done — as we said, they did it before, but the margin for error is gone.

● **We should have scheduled a cupcake**

All of the marquee contests in Week 1 had memorable moments, but there was a whole lot of sloppy football on display as well.

Such early jitters are a lot easier to forget if your team happened to be on the winning side of one of those top-10 showdowns, but if you were on the losing side you're probably lamenting not scheduling a tune-up against a Group of

Five school or a Football Championship Subdivision member first.

In theory, the Playoff committee's announcement that strength of schedule would be emphasized will discourage future cupcake scheduling, but those mismatches aren't going away. The fact is, they're useful. The teams from the lower divisions and non-power conferences need them to fund their athletic departments, and the stronger teams get the chance to work out kinks in live situations before diving into league play.

We might already have a couple of contrasting examples in the Sunflower State. Kansas State came up short against Iowa State in Dublin, then were nearly toppled by FCS challenger North Dakota, while a little way up the road Kansas is undoubtedly feeling a lot better about itself with decisive home wins against Fresno State and Wagner in hand.

It might be interesting to track how teams that played a tough opener fare compared to those that warmed up with a cupcake the rest of the way.

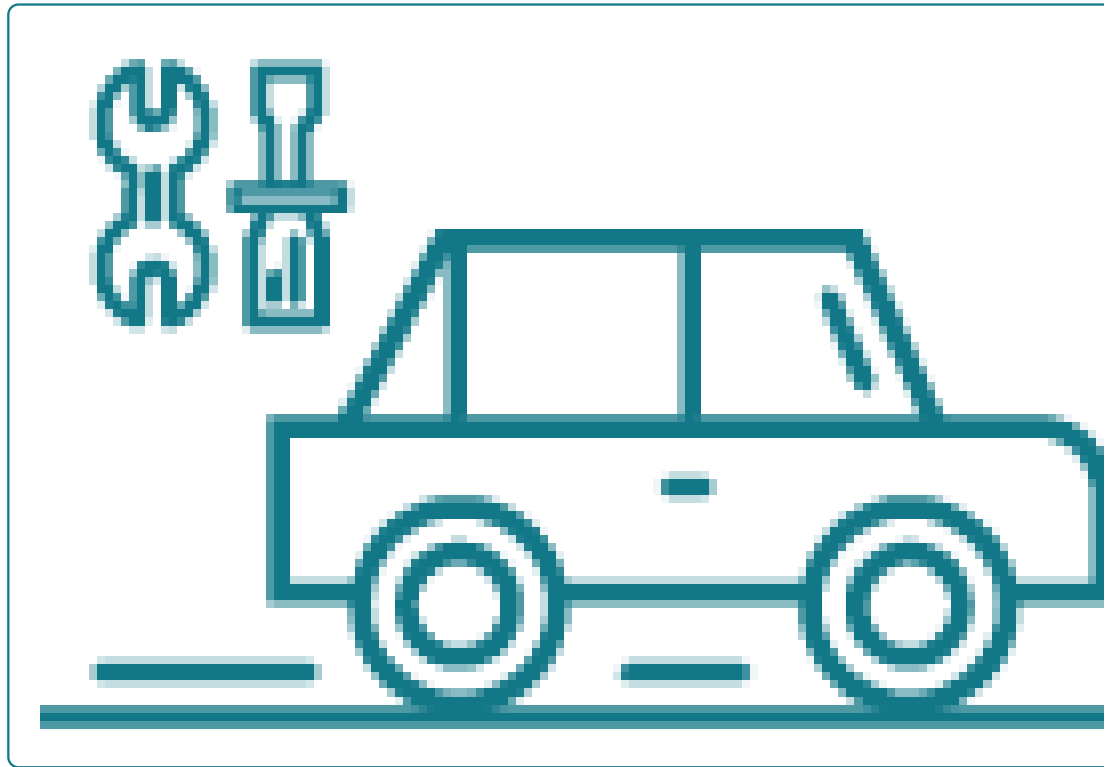
