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
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
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

Scheffler blows away field at Royal Portrush

PORTRUSH, Northern Ireland – The best players in professional golf have become accustomed to Scottie Scheffler's otherworldly ball striking performances on an almost weekly basis.

But when he puts the way he did this past week on the greens of Royal Portrush Golf Club, it's not a fair fight. He topped the field in strokes gained: approach and SG: putting to win the 153rd British Open on Sunday, July 20 in a rout by four strokes over Harris English.

Scheffler, 29, won his second major of the year, having claimed the PGA Championship in May, and his fourth career major title, and joins Jordan Spieth and Phil Mickelson as active players with three legs of the career Grand Slam. The other 155 golfers in the field could only marvel at their performance, stick out their hands, palms up, and ask, "What's the point?"

That was the question Scheffler posed during his pre-championship news conference when he explained that the euphoric winning feeling only lasted a few minutes, and added, "This is not a fulfilling life."


But it's the life he's dreamed of from a young age, when he wore pants in 100 degree weather because that's what he saw the pros where. He got laughed at, he said, "but that's what I wanted to do; I wanted to be a professional golfer, so I wore pants."

Scheffler's had the last laugh, and on July 17 the world No. 1 went out and shot a scrappy 3-under 68 in the toughest conditions of the week while hitting just three fairways. He then put on a clinic with eight birdies en route to 64 and claimed the 36-hole lead.

"I played with him the first two days, and honestly I thought he was going to birdie every hole. It was incredible to watch," said Shane Lowry, the 2019 Open champion at Portrush. "When he starts getting on that roll, he's a hard person to beat."

Scheffler shot a bogey-free 67 in the third round to stretch his lead to four. Even Rory McIlroy conceded that Scheffler's name being etched on the Claret Jug was a safe bet: "It's inevitable. Even when he doesn't have his best stuff, he's become a complete player. He's improved so much with his putter."

On Sunday, July 20, County Antrim's summer stretched two full days long. With fans lathered in suntan lotion to enjoy the brilliant sunshine and unusu-

ally balmy, benign conditions rarely associated with the British Open, Scheffler spun his approach from 146 yards at the first to 16 inches, the closest shot to the hole all day to set up a birdie.

In case it wasn't clear that he meant his business, he rolled in birdie putts at Nos. 4 and 5 and for a moment his lead had grown to eight. There were a few early wobbles to be sure – missed greens at Nos. 6 and 7 – but Scheffler's putter bailed him out with lengthy putts. He was putting as good if not better than those Texan wizards with the short stick – Ben Crenshaw in his day and Jordan Spieth in his prime. He got a little greedy in a revetted fairway bunker at the eighth and hit the steep slope, resulting in his lone double bogey of the championship. Still, he only made three bogeys all week and avoided any calamity – playing Calamity Corner, the treacherous par-3 16th, in 3 under.

Scheffler's lead was trimmed to four shots, but his greatest strength is his mind and he bounced back with an angry 350-yard drive at No. 9, stuffed a lob wedge inside 10 feet and rolled in another birdie putt. He tacked on a birdie at the par-5 12th and reeled off six stress-free pars in a row to cruise to his 17th PGA Tour title and fourth of the season.

It marked Scheffler's 10th consecutive win when holding the 54-hole lead. He just needs to do it 27 more times to

match Tiger Woods. But the comparisons to Tiger are growing. In one of the crazier stats to surface in a long time, Tiger had taken 1,197 days from his first major win to his fourth major win. Scheffler? It had taken him exactly the same number of days to achieve the feat.

"Having watched Tiger play in his prime – and I think Tiger is the greatest player I've ever seen – I never thought in my lifetime I'd see a player as close to Tiger as this man currently is," said NBC's Jim "Bones" Mackay. "Scottie Scheffler just blows my mind every time I watch him play."

But Scheffler downplayed the Tiger-like hype. "I still think they're a bit silly," he said. "Tiger won, what, 15 majors? This is my fourth. I just got one-fourth of the way there. I think Tiger stands alone in the game of golf. He was inspirational for me growing up."

But his fellow competitors look at that as Scheffler being modest. They know better.

"I don't think we thought the golfing world would see someone as dominant as Tiger come through so soon, and here's Scottie sort of taking that throne of dominance. You can't even say he's on a run. He's just been killing it for over two years now," 2024 British Open champion Xander Schauffele said. "He's a tough man to beat, and when you see

his name up on the leaderboard, it sucks for us."

"He is the bar that we're all trying to get to at this point," added McIlroy.

No one ever could cut into Scheffler's four-stroke lead. English closed with birdies on two of his final three holes to shoot 66 and claim second, a stroke better than Scottish Open winner Chris Gotterup (67), who had a great two-week stretch on this side of the pond. Wyndham Clark fired a 65 to finish T-4 with Englishman Matt Fitzpatrick and China's Haotong Li, who was Scheffler's final-round playing partner. Schauffele (68) tied for seventh with Northern Ireland's McIlroy and Scotland's Robert MacIntyre. Bryson DeChambeau made 19 birdies over the final three rounds and posted the low score of the final round, a 64, to rally from an opening-round 78 and finish T-10.

But it was Scheffler who got to enjoy his two minutes of ecstasy as he blew away the field at Royal Portrush to be the Champion Golfer of the Year. On the 18th green, he flung his cap high in the air as he caught sight of son Bennett and went to pick him up. His father, Scott, right arm in a sling following shoulder surgery, retrieved the cap, and with his one good arm couldn't resist snapping a photo of the famed yellow leaderboard wishing Scheffler congratulations on his latest achievement. There will be no Instagram posts or media tours because that's not what Scheffler's about.

"He doesn't care to be a superstar. He's not transcending the game like Tiger did. He's not bringing it to a non-golf audience necessarily. He doesn't want to go do the stuff that a lot of us do, corporately, anything like that," Spieth said, adding that his personality is different "from any other superstar that you've seen in the modern era and maybe in any sport. I don't think anybody is like him."

Spieth said Scheffler has that unique ability to separate his golf life from his work life and family and faith come first. Golf is not Scheffler's identity. When he's home in Dallas, there are two Chipotle restaurants nearby.

"There's one right where I grew up, kind of near SMU's campus. If I was to go to that Chipotle and try to eat nowadays, it would be very difficult for me," he explained. "There's another one in a different part of town that I'm not going to tell you where it is, but if I go there, nobody recognizes me ever."

Perhaps they would if he showed up with the Claret Jug in tow.

Gerard continues first-timers trend at Barracuda

While most of the golf world's attention was on the British Open, there was an opposite-field event on the PGA Tour taking place.

The Barracuda Championship, the final opposite-field tournament in 2025, offered a \$4 million purse, a \$720,000 first-place prize and 300 FedExCup Points, critical for those vying for a top 70 spot in the FedExCup Playoffs.

Former North Carolina Tar Heel Ryan Gerard, 25, tallied 47 points in the lone tournament on the PGA Tour to use the modified Stableford scoring system to win by three points over 2021 champion Erik van Rooyen at the Old Greenwood course at Tahoe Mountain Club in Truckee, California.

In the Barracuda, positive numbers are good. Golfers earn eight points for an albatross, five for an eagle, two for birdie, zero for par, minus-1 for bogeys and minus-3 for double bogey or worse.

After 54 holes, Gerard was tied with

Rico Hoey at 34 points but Gerard's 13-point fourth round was enough to hold off the field. Todd Clements put together a 16-point final round to finish third. Beau Hossler had the most points (17) in the final round and tied Max McGreevy for fourth, 10 points back.

Gerard is the 11th first-time winner on the PGA Tour in 2025. But did he see this win coming?

"I want to say yes, but you never really know in this game. Been playing a lot of really good golf. Felt like I haven't been quite getting the scores out of the shots that I've hit," he said.

"It's been a long time being a long grind, and, yeah, it's pretty cool to end up on top."

While he had five bogeys on July 20, he offset them with two eagles and four birdies. Those two final-round eagles were his only two of the week.

"It's just like a culmination of like a lifetime of work. I can't tell you like how many hours I've spent hitting golf balls dreaming of winning on the PGA Tour," he said. "Yeah, it's really special."

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Birdie barrage lifts Kitayama into playoffs

On a sweltering hot and humid day in Blaine, Minnesota, Kurt Kitayama was even hotter than the temperature.

The 32-year-old pro from Chico, California, tied the TPC Twin Cities course record with an 11-under 60 in the third round and picked up where he left off at the start of the final round July 27. Trailing by one entering the last day, Kitayama birdied five of the

first six holes and toured the front nine in 29 to build a three-stroke lead. With his older brother, Daniel, filling in on the bag for the rest of the season, Kitayama hung on to shoot 65 for a one-stroke victory over Sam Stevens at the 3M Open.

"This win's going to be extra special having him on the bag," Kitayama said. "Very cool experience and really happy he's part of it."

Kitayama carded 20 birdies, the most birdies or better made on the weekend by a PGA Tour winner since 2003, and finished with a 72-hole total of 23-under 261 for his second PGA Tour title.

Kitayama opened with a 65 but barely made the cut after shooting par 71 when he lacked control of his ball flight. At the range he hit balls and talked to his coach, Chris Como. "Felt like I found something that I could go with," he said.

Did he ever. Kitayama made his move on moving day with a career-low round of 60 that was five strokes better than his previous best score this season. He remained red hot in the final round and his iron game was as sharp as cheddar.

He stuffed a wedge inside a foot from 120 yards at No. 2, chipped in from 23 feet at No. 3 and stuffed another wedge to a foot at No. 5. He made 17 birdies in a span of 24 holes and tacked on another at the 201-yard par-3 eighth hole, sticking his tee shot to 4 feet.

"It was video game golf," said PGA Tour Radio's Dennis Paulson.

The back nine had its share of stressful moments. Kitayama had a hiccup at No. 11, bogeying the par 4 after tugging his drive into trouble. His lead was reduced to two over Jake Knapp, who finished in a tie for third with Matt Wallace (64) and Pierceson Coody (67). But Kitayama bounced back with a birdie at 12 and then lifted a 7-iron from the right fairway bunker to 2 feet at No. 14. "Shot of the day," CBS' Ian Baker-Finch exclaimed. He brushed in the putt to get to 24 under. All told, he made 32 total birdies, tying for the third-most in a 72-hole event on the PGA Tour since 1983. Stevens charged home in 31 and Kitayama's advantage was cut to one when he made a bogey at 17. But he had enough cushion to make a par at the last and hang on for the win over Stevens, who closed in 66.

Kitayama entered the week with two top-10 finishes in 18 starts this season and was mired in 110th place in the FedExCup season-long standings. With the 3M Open as the penultimate event of the PGA Tour's regular season, Kitayama picked a good time to dial in his iron game, ranking first in the field in strokes gained: approach the green (9.666). He improved to No. 53 and is safely in the top 70 to qualify for the first Playoff event.

Harrington snags second consecutive senior major

Another major, another celebration for Padraig Harrington.

He won the ISPS Handa Senior Open at Sunningdale in Berkshire, England. He signed for a 3-under 67 in the final round to finish the championship at 16 under, three shots clear of the field.

It's the second consecutive senior major title for the 53-year-old Irishman. He won the U.S. Senior Open by one shot over Stewart Cink in Colorado Springs last month.

This one is especially meaningful, though, considering Harrington, who won back-to-back British Opens in 2007 and 2008, had finished second in the British Senior Open twice before.

Harrington made eagle on the first hole in his final round, growing his lead from two to three over Justin Leonard. After posting 32 on the outward nine, it appeared as if Harrington would run away with it, but there was a brief moment on the back nine when that wasn't a sure thing.

Thomas Bjorn charged with three birdies in four holes, but then he made bogey on No. 16 shortly after Harrington made birdie on No. 14, dashing Bjorn's hopes of lifting the trophy.

LIV: Niemann earns 5th 2025 win

Joaquin Niemann started the week by parting with his caddie and coach after missing the cut at the British Open Championship. He ended it in a similar fashion to how he has four other LIV Golf events this season: on top.

Niemann won for the fifth time in

2025, running away with the title at LIV Golf UK at JCB Golf and Country Club. He finished at 17-under 196, beating Bubba Watson by three shots.

It's another \$4 million payday for Niemann, who increases his lead on top of the LIV Golf individual standings with two events left in the season, coming in Chicago and Indianapolis. LIV Golf's season finale in Michigan is the team championship.

Watson's second-place finish was his best since joining LIV Golf. Caleb Surratt had his first podium finish for LIV Golf, placing third at 13 under.

In the team competition, Jon Rahm's Legion XIII won by eight shots over Niemann's Torque GC.


